

He not only set the tone for operations at Palmetto Brick, but also for four generations of the Anderson family, who have directed the company as master craftsmen ever since.

The one constant in the company's long history has been the continuation of Mr. Anderson's vision: his emphasis on value and his unwavering commitment to creating quality brick of strength and elegance.

Using the latest technology in brick-making, a new architectural facility was commissioned in 2005 to service the architectural community with a plethora of colors, sizes and textures that are essential for

modern designs. Rich, vibrant hues and through-thebody color palette provide architects unlimited design flexibility.

Today, Palmetto Brick is the largest family-owned brick maker in South Carolina, producing more than 150 million brick per year, and remains one of only a handful of American-owned and operated brick manufacturers in the U.S.






